

Waze Emergency Vehicle Ahead Alert

Overview

Applied Information now offers seamless integration with the Waze navigation app, providing real-time alerts to drivers approaching a stopped emergency vehicle attending to an accident on a major road or highway. The Waze alert is designed to improve the safety of first responders on scene by providing sufficient notice to drivers approaching the stopped emergency vehicle. This advanced warning allows the driver to react appropriately by moving one lane over and slowing down ahead of the accident scene. In addition, the Waze alert assists in providing crash alert information to motorists far in advance, so as to reduce the likelihood of secondary crashes that often occur as a result of the initial accident.

This safety feature is now available free of charge for new and existing Glance users, whose emergency vehicles are outfitted with the Applied Information Glance Preemption and Priority system's on-board unit. Waze alerts are triggered automatically by the on-board unit without the need for first responder driver intervention. When a Waze driver approaches an emergency scene, they will receive an audible warning, "Watch Out, Accident Ahead", and a visual alert reading, "Emergency Vehicle Attending to Incident". This integration creates an additional layer of safety for first responders and motorists alike.
